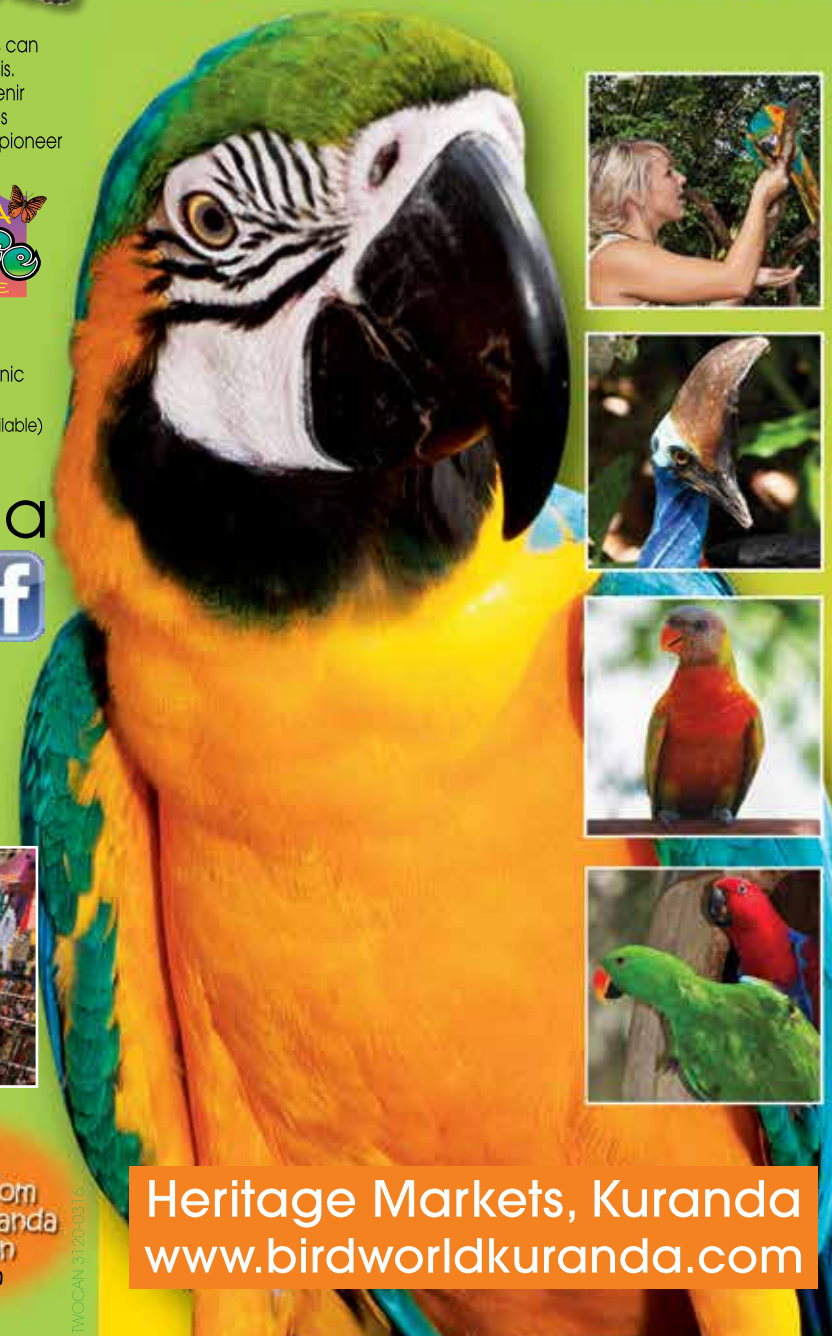

# Surround yourself with living colour!

Join the birds in their beautiful world when you surround yourself in their rainforest habitat. Flying around you are species from the vanishing rainforests of the world, including some of Australia's most precious and beautiful birds. There are brilliant Amazonian macaws, the endangered and stately cassowary, cheeky rainbow lorikeets, galahs, cockatoos and many more.

Birdworld replicates the natural habitats of almost 60 native and exotic species that roam the unique rainforest immersion exhibit.



Found in the rainforests of Cape York Peninsula, the Eclectus Parrot caused confusion amongst ornithologists for over a century. It was not until 1913 that the bright red and green parrots often seen together were accepted as being of the same species. With most parrots, the male is more brightly coloured than the female, but not so with the eclectus as the female has the vibrant red feathers.

Bring your camera - you'll be surrounded by hundreds of free flying birds.
